Jackson Hole People's Market - Rules & Regulations 2010 Non-Food Vendors

1. **LOCAL Producers ONLY.** The producer holding a booth must be present.
No stand-in exhibitors or sales representatives.

LOCAL ARTIST STATEMENT OF RESIDENCY

Policy: JH People's Market extends local status to producers living in the following counties in Wyoming and Idaho if they meet the criteria of resident in those counties: Teton County WY, Teton County ID, Lincoln County and Sublette County. We will also accept producers from the town of Dubois, WY.

Criteria: People who reside in two places, or those who commute part of the week, are considered residents of the place where they spend the most time. The State of Wyoming adds the concept of domicile to further clarify who is considered a legal resident of the State. A domicile refers to that place where a person has a true, fixed, and permanent home to which, whenever absent, the person has the intention of returning. A person may have more than one residence, but only one domicile. To be considered a legal resident of Wyoming, a person must have domiciled within Wyoming for a period of not less than one year and not claimed residency elsewhere for any purpose during the one-year period.

2. All products must be original, designed and produced by, or under the direct supervision of the exhibiting producer. No commercially-produced products. Only products that are represented on the submitted application may be displayed.
3. There is a \$10.00 non-refundable entry fee.
4. Booths must be open for business during the advertised market hours, 4-7pm on the Wednesday market they are selected for. Booth spaces are \$35 fee for a 10x10, and a \$70 fee for a 10x20. If you would like to share a booth it is \$20 a person for 10x10 or \$40 a person for 10x20. EZ Up style canopies required, preferably rainbow but white will work as well. No "price reduced" or "Sale" signs allowed in the booths.
5. Exhibitors must furnish their own display facilities. Please keep your booths off the grass and secured with weights.
6. Exhibitors display all works at their own risk. The JH People's Market is not responsible for damage, theft or loss of an exhibitor's property or personal injury resulting from participation in JH People's Market
7. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up their own space after the fair. Please leave it cleaner than you found it.
8. All sales will be made directly through exhibiting producers.
9. Exhibitors will be responsible for collection of 6% sales tax. Instructions for collection procedures will be mailed to exhibitors upon notification of acceptance.
10. In the event of a waitlist, booth fees will be retained until after the show.
11. The JH People's Market reserves the right to remove any exhibitor for violation of any regulations.
